Regarding your editorial about the UK's non-dom tax regime ([FT View](#), April 27) the US is scratching its head about changing from citizenship-based taxation, with American citizens taxed on their worldwide income, to a system of residence-based taxation, with Americans truly resident in another country not taxed on their foreign income.
